It can be assumed to have equivalent importance as practicals in science subjects.
- 3. **Project of Museum preparation :** The department works on department Museum project. In this the students are asked to prepare project on creative writers, giving special emphasis on extended knowledge about the writers, or unknown or unexplored facts that is pictures of their family house / furniture / original script etc.

- 4. Grammar Activity book : The department has prepared Grammar activity book, for UG first year students, to give them practice of grammatical module, in the class, as a method of experiment learning.
- 5. Vocabulary Diagnostic test : the department has prepared a booklet known as Vocabulary Diagnostic Test for UG Second year students, to give them a thorough practice of vocabulary items.

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2. Participating learning

The following methods are used as a mode of participative learning

- 1. Ask questions and make suggestions : students are free and encouraged to ask questions and make any suggestions that they want to during the class, so as to get maximum participation.
- 2. Role play : the PG students often enact / or do role play of the character of a drama in the class which is an important mode of participative learning.
- 3. Explanation of lesson by the student : After a portion is being taught by the teacher, the students are asked to explain the lesson again in the class , by his / her own way , so as to get maximum participation.
- 4. Students seminar / presentation : students are asked to present paper on topic given as a part of student seminar in the class get maximum participation.



3. Problem solving methologics

In problem solving methologics the department of English uses following methods

- 1. **Revision classes :** They are organized after each unit is covered in both UG and PG classes and specifically after the whole syllabus is covered and also before examination.
- 2. Guest lectures : The department organizes guest lectures , not specific topic , but also as a means to solve students problems on the topic , as the topic that are chosen for guest lectures as those in which the students have demand more clarification.
- 3. Students are given typed or <u>hand written notes</u> prepared by the faculties , for the topics in which the students face difficulties to answer.

An online "Tie and Dye" training programme was organized by the students of home science department, where students shared and taught their dying skill to the other students. A great response the students was recognized.








भूमिका

वेदाङ्ग

वेदों के सहायक शिक्षा, कल्प, व्याकरण, निरुक्त, छन्दस् और ज्योतिष इन छ शास्त्रों को वेदाङ्ग कहा गया है। जिस प्रकार अङ्गविहीन शरीर असम्भव है, उसी प्रकार इन छ: अङ्गों के अध्ययन के अभाव में वेदाध्ययन असम्भव है। वेदी के शुद्धपाठ, अर्थज्ञान, यज्ञों में मन्त्रों की उपयोगिता, यज्ञ के लिए उचित समय का ज्ञान तथा वेदि-निर्माण की सही प्रक्रिया का ज्ञान वेदाङ्गों के अभाव में सम्भव नहीं है। पाणिनि-शिक्षा में कहा गया है कि 'ज्योतिष्' वेदों के लिए आँख है, निरुक्त कान है, शिक्षा घ्राण है, व्याकरण मुख है, कल्प हाथ है, तथा छन्द पाँव हैं—

> छन्दः पादौ तु वेदस्य हस्तौ कल्पोऽथ पठ्यते । ज्योतिषामयनं चक्षुर्निरुक्तं श्रोत्रमुच्यते । । शिक्षा घ्राणं तु वेदस्य मुखं व्याकरणं स्मृतम् । तस्मात्साङ्गमधीत्यैव ब्रह्मलोके महीयते । ।

इस प्रकार जैसे आँख, कान, नाक, मुख, हाथ तथा पाँव से शरीर में पूर्णता रहती है, उसी प्रकार इन षड्वेदाङ्गों के अध्ययन से वेदाध्ययन में परिपूर्णता आती है। अब क्रमश: वेदाङ्गों का संक्षित परिचय प्रस्तुत किया जा रहा है—

शिक्षा— षड्वेदाङ्गों में शिक्षा का स्थान अत्यन्त महत्त्वपूर्ण है। यह <u>प्रथम वेदाङ</u> है। इसको वेद<u>ों की 'नासिक</u>ा' कहा गया है— 'शिक्षा घ्राणं तु वेदस्य'। यह शुद्ध उच्चारण का शास्त्र है— स्वरवर्णोंच्चारणप्रकारो यत्र शिक्ष्यते उपदिश्यते सा शिक्षा। जिस शास्त्र में मन्त्रों के स्वर एवं व्यञ्जनों के शुद्ध उच्चारण को जाना जाता है। वह 'शिक्षा' कहलाता है। स्वर तथा व्यञ्जनों का ठीक-ठीक उच्चारण हो मन्त्रों के वास्तविक अर्थ का अवबोधन कराता है।

यह शास्त्र यद्यपि अत्यन्त प्राचीन हैं; परन्तु इस पर लिखे प्रन्थों की संख्या अत्यल्प है। एक अनुश्रुति के अनुसार 'जैगीषव्य' के शिष्य 'बाभ्रव्य' इस शास्त्र के प्रवर्तक है। ऋग्वेद के क्रमपाठ की व्यवस्था भी इन्होंने ही की थी। 'महाभारत-शान्तिपर्व' के अनुसार आचार्य 'गालव' ने एक शिक्षाशास्त्रीय प्रन्थ का निर्माण किया था। अष्टाध्यायो में भी इसका उल्लेख पाया जाता है। 'भण्डारकर रिसर्च इंस्टीट्यूट, पूना' से 'भारद्वाज-शिक्षा' का प्रकाशन हुआ हैं; जिसके रययिता 'भरद्वाजमुनि' माने जाते हैं। वेदों के शाखा भेद के कारण शिक्षाएँ भी विविध प्रकार के उच्चारण विधानों को प्रस्तुत करती है। पाणिनि ने भी एक शिक्षा-ग्रन्थ का प्रणयन किया था, जो पाणिनि-शिक्षा के नाम से प्राप्त होता है। वाराणसी से 'शिक्षा-संग्रह' नामक एक ग्रन्थ प्रकाशित हुआ है, जिसमें अनेक शिक्षाएँ

के व्याख्याकारों के रूप में उल्लिखित किया है।

निरुक्त के प्रसिद्ध भाष्यकार के रूप में 'दुर्गाचार्य' का नाम विख्यात है। स्वयं यास्क ते अपने से पूर्ववर्ती अनेक निरुक्तकारों की सत्ता स्वीकार की है। कतिपय विद्वानों के अनुसार यास्क चौदहवें निरुक्तकार हैं। यास्क के अनुसार अन्य निरुक्तकारों के नाम इस प्रकार हैं — अग्रायण, औपमन्यव, औदुम्बरायण, और्णनाभ, कात्यक्य, क्रौष्टुकि, गार्ग्य, गालव, तैटीकि, वार्ष्यायणि, शाकपूणि तथा स्थौलाष्ठीवि।

निरुक्त में कठिन वैदिक शब्दों की व्युत्पत्ति दी गयी है तथा यह बतलाया गया है कि कौन सा शब्द किसी विशिष्ट अर्थ में क्यों रूढ़ हो गया है। निरुक्त का विषय है— वर्णागम, वर्णविपर्यय, वर्णविकार, वर्णनाश तथा धातु का उसके अर्थातिशय के साथ योग—

> वर्णगमो वर्णविपर्ययश्च द्वौ चापरौ वर्णविकारनाशौ । धातोस्तदर्थातिशयेन योगो तदुच्यते पञ्चविधं निरुक्तम् ।।

निरुक्तकार<u>सभी शब्दों को धातुज अर्थात</u>ु धातु और प्रत्ययों के योग से उत्पन्न मानते हैं।

वैदिक देवताओं के विषय में भी निरुक्त में विवरण प्राप्त होते हैं। यास्क के अनुसार देवताओ<u>ं के तीन</u> वर्ग हैं— पृथिवी स्थानीय देवता, अन्तरिक्ष स्थानीय देवता तथा दुलोक स्थानीय देवता।

छन्द— 'पाणिनि शिक्षा' में छन्द को वेद का 'पाद' बतलाया गया है— 'छन्द: पादौ तु वेदस्य' । जिस प्रकार पैरों के बिना किसी जीवधारी की गमन क्रिया असम्भव है, उसी प्रकार वेदमन्त्रों का पाठ छन्दोज्ञान के अभाव में नहीं हो सकता । जहाँ भी पद्यात्मकता होगी वहाँ छन्दात्मकता भी अवश्य होनी चाहिए । सर्वानुक्रमणी नामक प्रन्थ में कात्यायन ने स्पष्ट कहा है— यदक्षरपरिमाणं तच्छन्द: अर्थात् छन्द से यह ज्ञान होता है कि मन्त्र का पाठ कितने अक्षरपरिमाण में किया जाना चाहिए । सम्पूर्ण ऋग्वेद, सामवेद तथा अथर्ववेद पद्यमय हैं । इनके पाठ की व्यवस्था छन्द पर आधारित हैं । सम्भवतः इसीलिए 'छन्दस्' शब्द वेद का पर्याय बन गया है ।

Experiential learning-20-21 zoology


Experiential learning is the process of learning through experience, and is more narrowly defined as "learning through reflection on doing"

1.Dissections-Alternative methods of dissections are used, as animal dissections are banned by UGC and students of B.Sc.I and II yr themselves make models for dissection in the workshop in zoology lab, which they study and are used for examination also. 3.Experiments related to environment are also performed in the department.



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


2.3 Student centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies are used to enhance learning.

- Online student seminars were organized for the students of B. Sc. III and M. Sc. which promoted interactive learning.


