Module 2: Use of Microsoft Excel to prepare data sheets

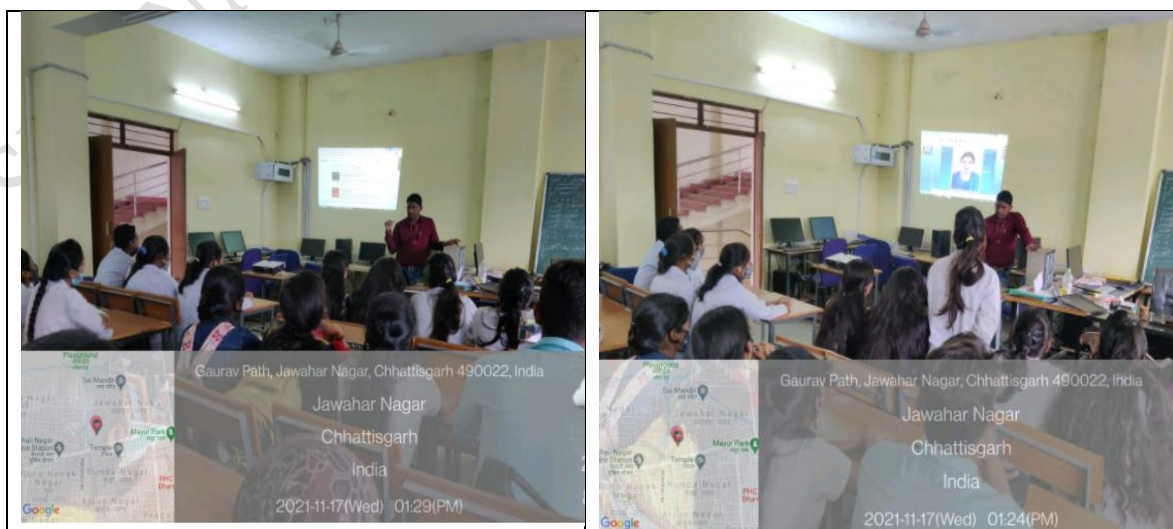
Module 3: Use of Microsoft Excel for calculations and graphical representations

Module 4: Use of Microsoft PowerPoint for slide preparations

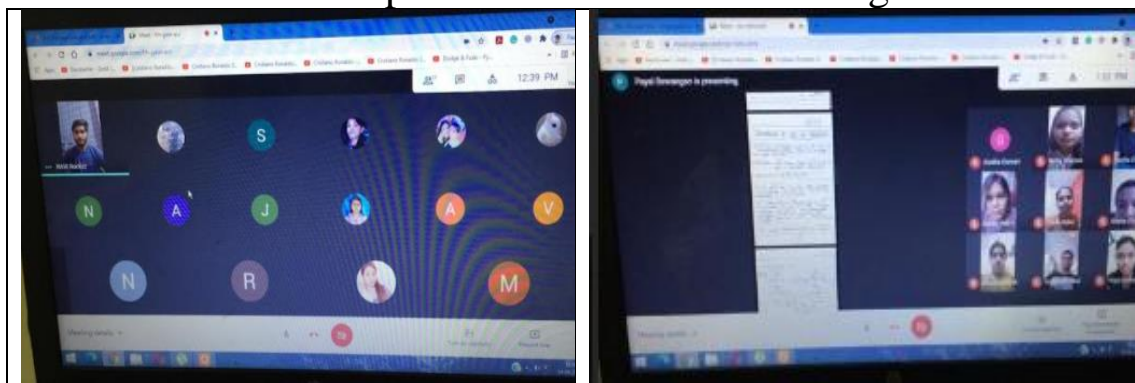
Module 5: Preparation of slides with effective animations
