



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is executed as of [Date] and sets out the collaboration framework by and between:

LAQSH Foundation, having its registered office at Ruby 37, Golden Enclave, Old Airport Road, Bangalore 560017, and **LAQSH Job Skills Academy Pvt. Ltd.**, having its registered office at **4th Floor, A1 Towers, Corporate Block, Golden Enclave, Bangalore – 560017**, (Hereinafter collectively referred to as "LAQSH," which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include their successors and permitted assigns) of the FIRST PART;

AND

Indira Gandhi Government PG College, having its registered office at **Vaishali Nagar, Bhilai, Dist-Durg (C.G.), 490023** (hereinafter referred to as "COLLEGE," which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and assigns) of the SECOND PART;

LAQSH and COLLEGE are individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

WHEREAS:

- **COLLEGE** offers Graduate & Post-Graduate academic programs and is committed to improving the employability outcomes of its students.
- **LAQSH** is engaged in job-oriented skills training and placement for youth across India, with over 17 years of experience in the skilling ecosystem. LAQSH operates in 770 government schools across 8 states, offering training in core employability and domain-specific skills such as Electronics, Retail, IT/ITeS, Banking, Tourism, Agriculture, Beauty & Wellness, and Plumbing.

OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU:

1. Offer high-quality employability skills training to graduate and final-year students.
2. Provide job placement opportunities through job fairs on campus and pooled drives.
3. Enable access to new-age career-readiness courses such as Digital Productivity using AI (certified by UNICEF).

SCOPE AND UNDERSTANDING

The College and LAQSH agree to collaborate in providing job-oriented skills training and job placement support to college students and recent graduates. This will involve mobilization, training delivery, and organizing placement drives.

COLLEGE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide adequate classrooms equipped with projectors and basic infrastructure.
- Ensure a minimum of 40 students per training batch.
- Identify a SPOC from the placement cell for coordination with LAQSH.
- Provide visibility to the program through college social media handles and local newspapers.
- Permit placement-related banners, posters, and student outreach within campus.
- Provide support in mobilizing eligible students and scheduling sessions.
- Allow LAQSH to counsel students and track interest/attendance.

LAQSH DELIVERABLES:

- Deliver training courses online or in hybrid/offline mode.
- Provide expert trainers, study materials, and session schedules.
- Give students access to LAQSH's Learning Management System (LMS).
- Conduct assessments and share feedback.
- Organize on-campus and pooled placement drives.
- Issue certificates for completed courses.
- Facilitate registration and documentation support.

TRAINING COURSES OFFERED:

Spoken English – Basic (20 hours)

Improve verbal and written communication for workplace readiness.

Life Skills (20 hours)

Focus on teamwork, time management, problem-solving, and adaptability.

Marketing & Sales Skills (20 hours)

Introduction to sales strategies, consumer behavior, and negotiation.

Chat GPT / AI for Graduates (10 hours)

Learn to use AI tools effectively in academic and work settings.

Resume Preparation & Interview Skills (10 hours)

Craft compelling resumes and build confidence for job interviews.

Digital Productivity using AI (UNICEF certified) (10 hours) : A self-paced course developed with UNICEF to enhance productivity using digital tools and AI.

Note: Students completing the required assessments will receive **certificates of completion**. Students maintaining **75% attendance** will be eligible to participate in placement drives.

TERM AND CONDITIONS:

- **Duration:** This MOU shall remain valid for 2 years from the date of signing, and may be extended by mutual consent.
- **Confidentiality:** Both parties agree to keep all student and operational data confidential.
- **Non-exclusivity:** Either party may collaborate with other organizations.
- **Modifications:** Amendments may be made in writing by mutual consent.
